2. INTRODUCTION

Avenview C-HDM-EXD-A Audio Extractor allows you to extract audio signals from your HDMI source. When connecting to a TV or display you don't always get the best audio, or in the case of a PC monitor, no audio at all. So with this Audio Extractor you can take your original HDMI audio signal and convert it to digital optical or analog Stereo (L/R) audio. This means that you can output your audio signal to external speakers or extend your audio signal pathway.

2.2 BEFORE INSTALLATION


- Put the product in a level and stable location. If the product falls, it may cause damage or malfunction to components within the casing.
- Do not place the product in temperatures under 0°C or over 50°C. High humidity may also cause the unit to malfunction.

- Do not twist or pull by force the ends of the UTP cable. It will cause malfunction.






CABLE INDEX

- ANALOG AUDIO L/R




2.4.1 FRONT/TOP PANEL (C-HDM-EXD-A)





- DC 5V: Connect to the 5V DC power supply into the unit and plug the adaptor to an AC wall outlet.
- The Power LED will illuminate in blue when the unit is connected to the power supply and switched on.
- 3. **Link LED:** The Link LED will illuminate in green when both the source and the display are connected and have established a link. This LED will also blink once while the power is turned on.


2.4.2 REAR PANEL (C-HDM-EXD-A)



- I. HDMI Out: Connect to the display (TV/monitor) with an HDMI cable for video and audio signal output. No HDMI output connection is required to send audio through the analog and optical outputs.
- Optical Out: Connect to audio equipment such as an amplifier or Hi-Fi system with an optical cable for digital audio output. Supports up to bitstream audio 5.1CH and LPCM 2CH.
- 3. L/R Out: Connect to audio equipment such as an amplifier or active speakers with a stereo RCA cable for audio output. Supports analog stereo output only.




2.4.3 RIGHT PANEL (C-HDM-EXD-A)



- I. TV/Bitstream/2CH LPCM: This switch allows users to select the source's audio EDID. TV Mode: Switch to TV mode for the HDMI source to output audio per the EDID of connected TV or AV receiver, supports up to LPCM 7.1 channels. Bitstream Mode: Switch to Bitstream mode for the HDMI source to output Bitstream audio per the built-in EDID, supports up to compressed audio 5.1 channels. 2CH LPCM Mode: Switch to 2CH LPCM mode for the HDMI source to output LPCM 2 channels audio per the built-in EDID.
- 2. **Power:** Switches the unit ON or puts the device into standby mode.

3. Link LED: The Link LED will illuminate in green when both the source and the display are connected and have established a link. This LED will also blink once while the power is turned on.

3. INSTALLATION (C-HDM-EXD-A)

To setup Avenview C-HDM-EXD-A please follow these steps for connecting to a device:

- 1. Turn off all devices including monitors / TV.
- 2. Connect a HDMI source (such as a Blu-Ray Disc player or PC) to the C-HDM-EXD-A HDMI IN.
- 2. Connect a HDMI/OPTICAL/LR source (such as a TV, Speaker, Amplifier) to the HDMI OUT.
- 9. Plug in 5V/.2 A DC power (supplied).
- 10. Power on HDMI Source.
- II. Power on the HDMI/OPTICAL/LR out source.
