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Section 1: Getting Started

1.1 Important Safeguards

Avenview C-MDP-HDMI The Mini DisplayPort to HDMI adapter enable you to connect any HDMI interface embedded device (Monitor, Projector etc.) with a Mini DisplayPort interface (Desktop, Laptop) and no need to purchase any DisplayPort embedded terminal device.

1.6 Before Installation

- Put the product in an even and stable location. If the product falls down or drops, it may cause an injury or malfunction.
- Don't place the product in too high temperature (over 50°C), too low temperature (under 0°C) or high humidity.
- Use the DC power adapter with correct specifications. If inappropriate power supply is used then it may cause a fire.
- Do not twist or pull by force ends of the optical cable. It can cause malfunction.



1.7 Installation

Follow these steps to connect Avenview C-MDP-HDMI converter:

1. Connect the Mini DisplayPort connector to the PC, Laptop or any other Mini DisplayPort source device
2. Connect HDMI connection to Monitor, TV or Projector
3. Turn on your Monitor/TV/Projector and then Mini DisplayPort source

Please ensure that the display resolution set in PC is supported by the Monitor/TV.
