2.2 **BEFORE INSTALLATION**

ATTENTION

3. INSTALLATION GUIDE

To setup the Avenview MP-1080HDM digital signage player follow the below steps:

- I. Power OFF all devices.
- 2. Connect an HDMI display or TV to the MP-1080HDM using HDMI cable
- 3. Connect a CAT-5e/6 to the MP-1080HDM to connect to local network
- 4. Plug in 5V DC power cord to the power jack of the receiving unit MP-1080HDM.
- 5. Power on all devices.
- 6. Set content via URL/http web address.(see page 9)
- 7. Download AV SignPRO Software and start uploading media conents via LAN or USB.
