It is recommended that users read this entire document before attempting the Network Setup to the SW-HDM3D-C6-4X4E/8X8E and fully understand all the steps and procedures outlined in this document.

NOTE – Please ensure your UTP Network cables are tested and crimped to TIA/EIA-568 Cabling Standards to ensure proper data transmissions and connectivity.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Before you begin the Network connectivity ensure the SW-HDM3D-C6-4X4E/8X8E and your PC is connected to AC power.
2. Ensure your PC is connected to the Matrix switch via the supplied USB to RS-232 cable.
3. PC Requirements-Windows® XP/Windows Vista®/Windows® 7/Windows® 8
4. Ensure your Laptop or desktop is plugged in to AC power during the setup process. It is not recommended to use only battery power during the setup. Do not remove power at any time from the connected devices during the setup process as this could lead to incomplete results.

NETWORK SETUP

1. Please ensure your IT department has provided the required Network information to setup the Matrix on the required network.

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


2. Follow the Setup instructions from the install wizard if you don't have Current Control Software
3. When the install is complete; Click on the Avenview desktop icon.
4. This will launch Avenview Matrix Control Software. It will open following "Serial Port" setting page.

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


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
STEP 1

When the device has established Connection via USB to RS-232. Please click the "NETWORK" Button



STEP 2

In the Device Setting window that appears. Please click Read From Device while in RS232 Mode.



STEP 3

Please enter the Required IP information to connect to your network. If it is a simple network please gather the information from your PC "IPCONFIG"



IP: 2-254 (Example 192.168.0.120)
MASK: Required (Example 255.255.255.0)
GATEWAY: Required(Example 192.168.0.1)
DNS 1:Required (Example 192.168.0.1)
DNS 2: Required (Example 192.168.0.1)

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STEP 4

Please "Click" on write to device



STEP 5

When the complete window POPs up .Please click on "OK" button.
Now you are Ready to connect via Ethernet



STEP 6

Please click the "NETWORK" Button.

In the Device Setting window that appears. Please select "Ethernet". A box will appear to enter in the IP address or it displays the correct IP you input earlier in the setup.

Last STEP ensure the "Network" icon  is selected as shown on the diagram. Now you can control the Matrix device via Ethernet
